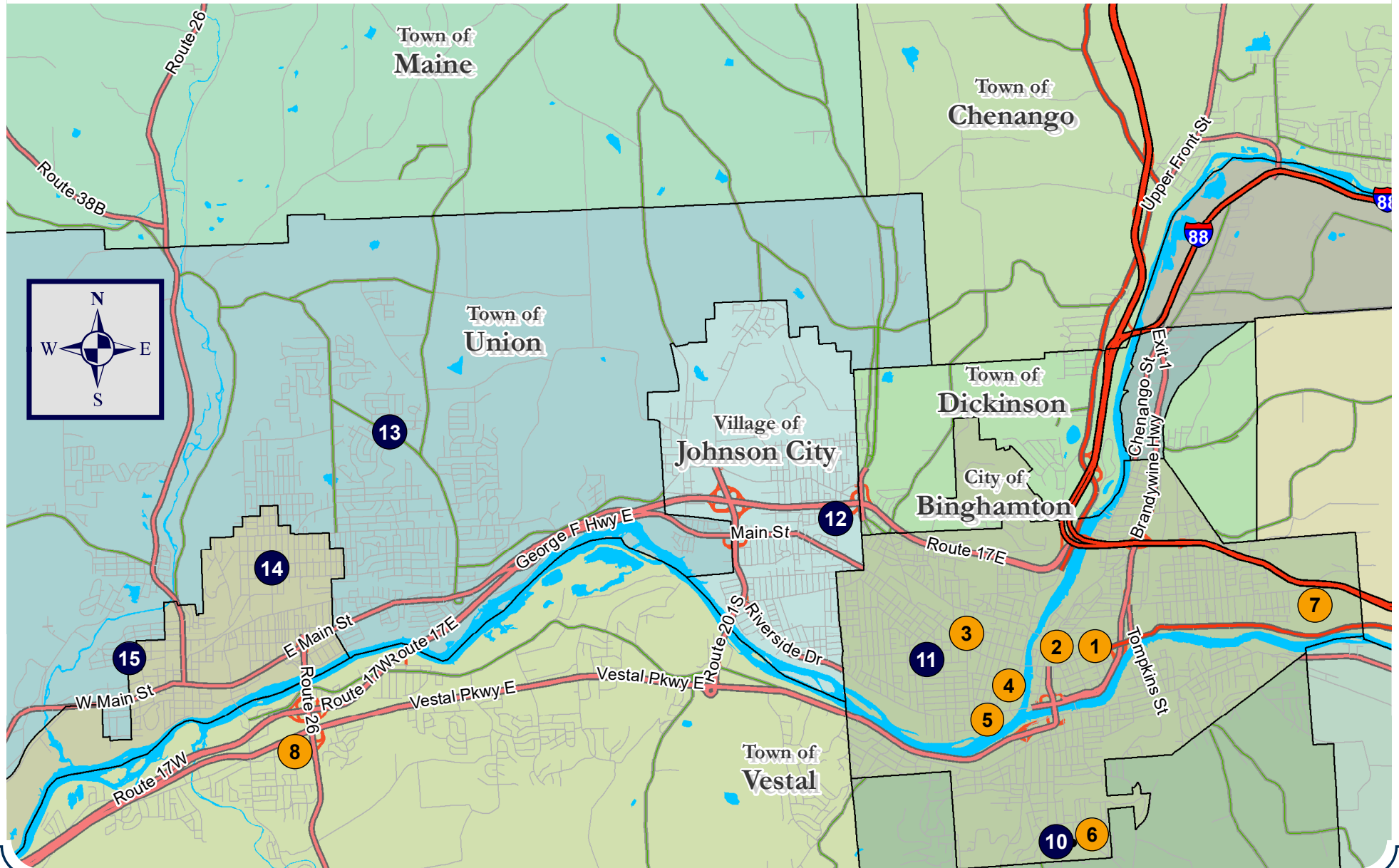

## 7 CASTLE ON THE HILL - VIRTUAL PHOTO TOUR OF NYS ASYLUM AT BINGHAMTON PRESENTED BY PAST

Saturday 6:30PM. Join FREE virtual rare guided tour of this National Register Landmark presented by Preservationist, Broome County Historian, and Preservation Association of the Southern Tier (PAST) Director Roger Luther. Sitting high on outskirts of Binghamton, its founder pioneered medical addiction treatment, its designer became a leading 19th century New York architect, and for over a century it served thousands but now sits empty, deteriorating, waiting for restoration and rebirth.
